## • *DRESS CODE* •

### *CLUBHOUSE:*

---

- Denim attire is only permitted Tuesday, Friday and Saturday evenings after 4:00p.m.
  - Tank tops, halter-tops, blouses or tops that expose a bare midriff and bathing attire are not permitted in the clubhouse or on the patio or porch.
  - Hats are to be removed by men and boys in the clubhouse with the exception of the Golf Shop.
  - Shoes must be worn. Golf shoes are permitted in the Valley Room, Dogwood Room, Patio and Porch.
  - Parents are responsible for the conduct and attire of their children. Members are responsible to assure that their guests adhere to the dress codes.
  - Golf attire is permitted in the Lounge, Valley Room, Dogwood Room, Patio, and Porch.
- The Club reserves the right to relax the dress codes or specify costume dress for special occasions with advance notice.

The staff is empowered to monitor the dress code, inform members of infractions, and report repeat infractions to the Board of Directors

### *GOLF COURSE:*

---

**Proper golf course attire is mandatory for members and guests while on the golf courses and practice areas.**

**Denim attire is NOT permitted**

- Men and boys are expected to wear a shirt with sleeves and a collar, turtleneck, or mock turtleneck. Shirts shall be properly worn: Shirts tailored to be tucked into slacks or shorts must be tucked in; shirts tailored to be worn outside slacks or shorts may be left out.
- Women and girls may wear sleeved or sleeveless blouses or shirts with collars, turtleneck, or mock turtleneck, or appropriate crew or V-neck collars.
- Tee-shirts, tank tops, and tops that expose a bare midriff are not permitted.
- Improper attire also includes any clothing that is ripped, torn, or soiled.
- Shorts for both men and women are to be no higher than six (6) inches above the center of the knee. Short shorts, gym shorts, team athletic shorts, tennis shorts, swim attire and cut-offs are not permitted.
- Shoes are to be worn at all times on the courses and practice areas. Egypt Valley Country Club is a non-metal spike facility.

The Golf Shop personnel have the authority to monitor the golf dress code. If an article of clothing is questioned and not changed, the Golf Shop has the authority to prohibit play, or may inform the Board of Directors and a letter will be sent to the member documenting the incident. Second violations will result in action by the Board of Directors and may result in suspension of privileges.
